

This is our fourth update.

We are continuing to look for people to lead our services over the coming months and are adding names to our list. The arrangements for July are:

- 2<sup>nd</sup> July: 10 am Morning Worship led by Fay Fearon, a Reader at St. Nicolas Church
- 9<sup>th</sup> July: **11 am** Holy Communion Service led by Archdeacon Jenny Tomlinson. The service will be followed by a Bring and Share Lunch and then the choir will be performing a concert in church.

23<sup>rd</sup> July: 10 am Morning Worship led by Stephen Wright, a Lay Preacher at St. Nicolas Church 30<sup>th</sup> July: 10 am Holy Communion led by Revd. John Nightingale

- We have had to delay restarting the live streaming of services in June as Georgina was ill. We are now hoping to restart livestreaming during July.
- The website: Georgina has started making some changes and will continue to do so. Changes to the website will be discussed at this month's PCC meeting.
- The Leaders' Team (people involved with the organisation of church services) met on Friday 23rd June to discuss our plans for worship. The team has planned a range of services until the end of the year. We are continuing to look for vicars to lead Holy Communion services as well as using readers from other churches and members of our own church to lead Morning Worship or special services.
- The Weekly Prayer Group restarted of Monday afternoon between 3 pm and 4 pm on WhatsApp led by Janet. Several people joined in either 'live' or later that day
- The Cho family have moved out of the Vicarage. The Diocese have informed us that they have had discussions about who will live there in the future and have said they will let us know when a final decision has been made.
- Janet attended an Oversight meeting along with a representative from each of the other four churches in our area. They have created a list of contact details and have also shared when each church has a service during the week. Currently only two of the other churches have midweek services:

St. Laurence, Northfield: Holy Communion based on the Book of Common Prayer at 10 am on Wednesday

St. John's, Longbridge: Holy Communion at 10 am on Thursday.
