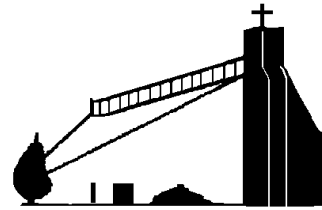
Safeguarding
