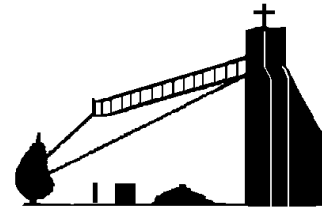

Thought for the Week: Divine Sight by Ian Bradley

The disciples found it difficult to believe that Jesus could attend to individuals en masse, yet still see them as individuals.

Jesus was no less concerned about Jairus and his problem, than about the woman needing immediate attention. And his extra-sensitivity could distinguish between the jostling of the crowd, and a clutch of faith.

We may not be able to comprehend Jesus' cosmic overview of humanity; but we can walk through today's gospel reading (Mark 5 21-43) with Jesus, and appreciate how carefully and considerately he deals with all concerned.
