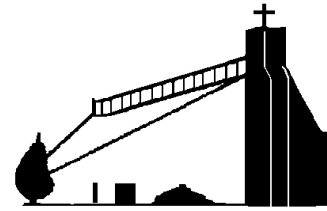
Safeguarding
