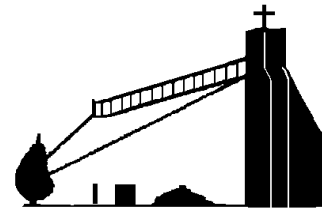
Safeguarding
