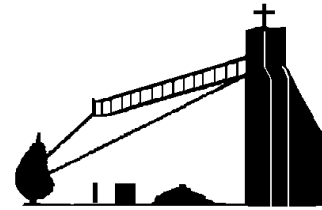

### Thought for the Week: Look to God by Ian Bradley

Keeping on keeping on, relying only on God, is so often the hardest thing to do.

Bringing faith to bear on a problem does not mean praying to God and then sitting back and waiting for something to turn up. We need to pray, certainly, and then to expect God to answer: to believe that he has given us the answer for which we asked. 'Whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours' (Mark 11:24).

It is not our ingenuity that wriggles us out of a tight corner, but faith in God's ability.
